

## **Ernest Edward Thompson**

Ernest was the son of Colin and Laura Thompson of Torksey Lock. He was a labourer, and had two brothers and three sisters. He joined the 1st battalion, the Lincolnshire regiment as a Private on the 21st May 1909 and his service number was 8764. His records have the hand-written annotation "To be regarded for official purposes as having died on or since 1st November 1914". He is remembered on Panel 21 of the Menin Gate Memorial at Ypres, Belgium.
