

## **Frederick Thompson Wallace**

Frederick was a farm labourer from Fenton, the only son of Frederick and Mary Thompson. He was born in 1898 and joined up at Lincoln on 26th September 1916 aged 18 years and 351 days old. He went to the 5th Battalion of the Machine Gun Corps, with a service number of 82188.

He was posted to Clipstone on 15th December 1916, and to Grantham on 12th February 1917. He was admitted to Belton Park Military Hospital on 15th March 1917 with German Measles and discharged on 28th March 1917. He was readmitted with a fresh infection of measles on 30th April 1917 and died on 11th May 1917. He is buried here at Kettlethorpe.
