

Harold Green

Harold was born at Branston, the son of James and Mary Green of Ivy Cottage, Kettlethorpe. He enlisted in Retford and joined the 1st Battalion of the Sherwood Foresters as Private Number 100069. He died on 25th April 1918 aged 19. He is recorded on the Pozieres Memorial in the Somme department of France. It records the names of 14,692 British and South African soldiers with no known grave killed between 21st March 1918 and 8th August 1918 during the Second Battle of the Somme in the period known as the Spring Offensive. It was unveiled on 4th August 1930.
