

John E Sensicall

John was born in Doncaster and was the son of Martha Bainborrow of Fenton. His residence was listed as Newton and he enlisted at Gainsborough. He joined the Lincolnshire Regiment as a Private Number 50603, but was in the 15th Battalion of the Lancashire Fusiliers as a Private, Number 55141 in the autumn of 1918. He died on 30th September 1918 aged 22 and is buried at Joncourt East British Cemetery, Grave Reference A.7. The cemetery contains 71 World War 1 burials, all from the period 30 Sep 18 - 3 Oct 18 and was designed by W H Cowlshaw.
