

Sydney Robert Snell

Sydney was the son of Richard and Elizabeth Snell, the millers and bakers of Laughterton, and husband of Mary Ann Snell. He enlisted in Forfar and joined the 1st Battalion the Royal Scots Fusiliers as Private Number 204545. He died on 26th September 1917 and is buried at Tyne Cot Cemetery between Ypres and Pashendale in Flanders, Belgium. Tyne Cot is the biggest British cemetery and contains 11,953 burials, of which 8,366 are of unknown soldiers. Sydney's grave reference is XXV. G. 23.
