

## **William Allen**

William was born in Fenton, his mother was Mrs S J Allen. He enlisted in Lincoln, and went into the 1st Battalion of the Lincolnshire Regiment as Private number 38830. He was killed in action on 21st March 1918 aged 32. His name is on Panel 23 and 24 of the Pozieres Memorial in the Somme department of France. It records the names of 14,692 British and South African soldiers with no known grave killed between 21st March 1918 and 8th August 1918 during the Second Battle of the Somme in the period known as the Spring Offensive. It was unveiled on 4th August 1930.
